APPLICATION CRITERIA

- Only AVPN members are eligible to apply for the awards.
- In 2023, the Constellations Awards celebrate **multi-sectoral collaborations** which puts a special focus on creating a **more equitable world for women and girls in Asia**.
- The collaboration must include at least 1 AVPN member organisation.
- Collaborations can be submitted as long as they have started, are in progress, or have been completed within the past 1 year.
- Ongoing collaborations should have been running for at least 1 year at the point of submission.
- The main activities of the collaboration must be located in Asia Pacific.
- To qualify, all applicants must submit **both**:
 - the application form via Survey Monkey; and
 - a 1-minute video of the team that answers the questions:
 - **What are the gender challenges in Asia that your collaboration is solving?**
 - **How does your collaboration solve the gender gap issues at hand and what are the achievements to date?**

Further instructions for video:

1. Please make sure your video does not go over 1 minute.
 2. Videos recorded via a webcam/mobile camera are acceptable. Voice clarity is the most important feature we are looking for.
- Please submit your application no later than **28 February 2023, 23:59h Singapore Time (GMT+8)**.
 - Application must only be submitted in English through this link (<https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/constellations2023>) and follow the requirements of the application form.
 - The application will be disqualified if:
 - The submitted application is incomplete or the video is not submitted.
 - The collaboration does not include at least 1 AVPN member organisation.
 - The collaboration reflects investor-investee or funder-grantee relationships.
 - Applicants must not submit any false documents or information and they must follow the requirements of the overview. If the provided information does not meet the requirements, AVPN reserves the right to decline the application. Should the investigation prove the information provided by any organisations to be false, they will be disqualified from the award.

12. Common Agenda - 20%: All partners have a shared vision for change, one that includes a common understanding of the problem and a joint approach to solving it through agreed upon actions.

13. Common progress measures - 20%: Collecting data and measuring results consistently on a list of indicators at the community level and across all participating organisations not only ensures that all efforts remain aligned, it also enables the participants to hold each other accountable and learn from each other's successes and failures.

- What are the common metrics of success?
- How do the partners account for one another's progress in this collaboration?

Please keep your response to no more than 500 words.

14. Mutually Reinforcing Activities - 20%: Successful collaborations depend on a diverse group of stakeholders working together, not by requiring that all partners do the same thing, but by encouraging each partner to undertake the specific set of activities at which it excels in a way that supports and is coordinated with the actions of others.

- Who are the stakeholders involved in this collaboration and how are their strengths harnessed to achieve the goals of this collaboration?
- What are the additional benefits that the collaboration has brought to this project?

Please keep your response to no more than 500 words.

15. Continuous Communication - 20%: Developing trust among different stakeholders in a collaboration is a huge challenge. Open and continuous communication is needed across all partners to build trust, assure mutual objectives, and create common motivation.

- How was trust built and open and continuous communication ensured amongst all partners and stakeholders?

Please keep your response to no more than 500 words.

16. Backbone support organisation - 20%: The backbone organisation is a team of dedicated staff separate from the participating organisations who can plan, manage, and support the initiative through ongoing facilitation, technology and communications support, data collection and reporting, and handling the myriad logistical and administrative details needed for the initiative to function smoothly.

- Was a separate team/entity set up to manage the collaboration? What were the functions of this team?
- What were the challenges and successes of having this backbone support?
